Methodology

Content is presented using clearly defined concepts, whistleblower protection frameworks, and simplified organizational case examples that reflect real workplace situations. The approach aligns with a new manager leadership course philosophy, focusing on awareness, responsibility, and leadership judgment rather than conducting investigations or legal analysis.

Interaction is balanced between individual reflection and light group discussions, allowing participants to explore ethical perspectives and leadership challenges in a controlled learning environment. Training materials include structured summary sheets, a comprehensive workbook, and simple reference templates that managers can use as guidance tools. Practical elements are intentionally minimal and limited to short quizzes, guided discussions, or basic scenario reviews. Optional pre-work or follow-up support may be provided upon request only.
